

**Focus Subject:** Literature

## *Overview*

Seeds are sown in the dirt to grow plants. The seeds with help from rain and sun begin to sprout into a small plant that breaks through the soil. Soon the plant is fully grown.

*We will learn:*

- Plants are grown from seeds.
- Seeds are planted in the soil.
- Rain (water) and sun help the seed sprout and grow.
- Seed is spelled 'S'-'E'-'E'-'D'.

## *Instructions*

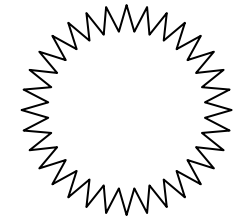
### **Coloring Activity**

**Purpose:** (a) Re-enforce the letters 'S', 'E', and 'D', (b) learn the spelling of 'SEED', (c) re-enforce seeds are placed in the soil to grow into plants such as flowers.

1. **Explain** to the children we are going to color the letters that spell 'SEED'.
2. **Point out** the letters 'S'-'E'-'E'-'D' spell 'SEED'.
3. **Tell** the children (while pointing to the seed illustrations) when we plant a seed, with water and sunshine, slowly the seed will sprout and grow into a plant, such as a flower plant.

# SEED

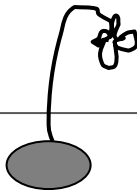
Seeds grow into plants like this flower plant!
